# Building Relationships/Networking:

- **District Team/Organizational Chart:** District Data Coordinator (Know your role!), Superintendent, Principals, Director of SPED, Business Office Official, Registrar, Guidance (Counseling)
- **District Department Breakdown:** Human Resources, Food Service, SPED, Information Technology, etc.
- **Regional Resources:** *Regional Information Centers (RIC), Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES), Neighboring District Data Coordinators (SEDREF Business Portal)*
- **State Resources:** *New York State Education Department (NYSED), Special Education Data Collection System, Analysis Reporting (SEDCAR), Office of Student Support Services (SSEC), Office of Information and Reporting Services (IRS)*

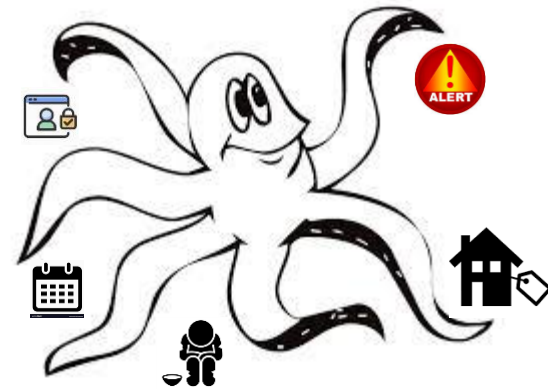

- ***School Safety and the Educational Climate (SSEC): Formerly VADIR/DASA – NYSED (Office of Support Services)***
- ***Civil Rights: Office of Civil Rights***
- ***Teacher Access and Authorization (TAA): NYSED (Office of Information and Reporting Services)***

- Student Data Privacy
- Economically disadvantaged (free college apps, SAT/AP fees waived, free lunch, CHS fees waived, Title 1 funding and eligibility for grants)

- Emergency notification system
- APPR: Teacher/Principal livelihood
- Real estate - value of homes
- Enrollment numbers/athletic class identification
